- dot (for a website or an email address) a period / a full stop
- Ⓐ at (for an email address, like pointing to a specific location)
.com .edu .org
- # hashtag (to label a conversation or a topic on FB or Twitter) FR : croisillon
- #1 = number one pound on mobile
- _ underscore (low, at the bottom to give emphasis, looks like there's a space)
- / (forward) slash (to navigate between folders)
- \ backslash
- * asterisk (to make a note / a footnote / a comment / a correction)
- hyphen (used to join two words)
- dash (to add comments or emphasis, similar to : colon)
- Caps lock** (all the letters are capital letters)
- [] (square) brackets
- () parenthesis (or round brackets)

- < less than > greater than = equals sign
- , comma ; semicolon : colon
- ' apostrophe
- & ampersand FR esperluette
- ! exclamation mark ? question mark
- + plus sign - minus sign % percent sign
- “ ” double quotes « » angle quotes
- { } curly brackets / braces
- | vertical bar / slash
