**England** and **Wales** are in favour of Brexit

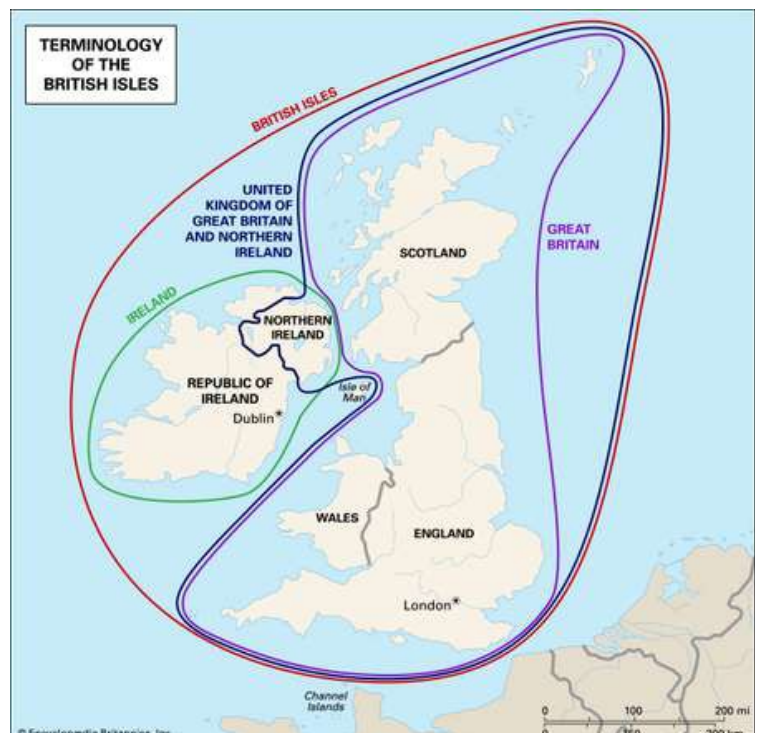
**Scotland** and **Northern Ireland** are against Brexit
